RE: Annual Certification

Dear Dr. Bandong:

On October 14 and 15, 2025 Eurofins Food Integrity and Innovation was evaluated to determine compliance with standards of performance, as established by the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment Rule (5 CCR 1005-5) for Hemp Testing Laboratories.

Based upon the on-site inspection and receipt of plan of correction documentation submitted between November 14 and December 15, 2025, the CDPHE has granted certification for Eurofins Food Integrity and Innovation to be certified from January 1, 2026 through December 31, 2026 in the testing categories of:

- ☐ Mycotoxins
- ☐ Total THC and other Cannabinoid Potency
- ☐ Percent Moisture
- ☐ Pesticides
- ☐ Residual Solvents
- ☐ Metals

This recommendation is contingent upon receipt and approval of all supporting documents, which must be completed by the date(s) indicated in the plan of correction.

Certification is specific to the laboratory's scope of accreditation per matrix and per analyte. The laboratory is prohibited from conducting regulated compliance testing on matrices/analytes not listed on the scope of accreditation. The certifying authority is the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE). Certification of a Hemp Testing Laboratory is at the sole discretion of the CDPHE and may be granted, limited or revoked by the CDPHE.
